Within days, the D.C. City Council will consider legislation to legalize assisted suicide. This bill is discriminatory because it would disproportionately target poor and vulnerable persons including senior citizens and those with disabilities and mental health challenges, often denying them appropriate health care, legal safeguards and choices on how they live their lives.

**About the Legislation:** B21-38 would allow doctors to prescribe a lethal dose of drugs to patients who have been deemed mentally competent and received a terminal diagnosis. **The bill is flawed, unsafe, unnecessary, and wrong for the District of Columbia.** 

## B21-38: BAD FOR PATIENTS, BAD FOR FAMILIES, BAD FOR DC

- 1. No doctor, nurse, or independent witness is required to be present when the lethal dose is taken, creating serious potential for abuse.
- 2. No family notification is required in advance.
- 3. People can pick up lethal prescriptions like any other drug at a local pharmacy.
- 4. Patients are not required to receive a mental health screening for depression before receiving a lethal prescription.
- 5. It's impossible to predict a terminal diagnosis accurately.
