The Cathedral is located at 1725 Rhode Island Avenue, N.W., between Connecticut Avenue and 17th Street. The Cathedral is open Sunday from 6:30AM until 7:00PM, Monday through Friday from 6:30AM until 6:30PM, and Saturday from 7:30AM until 7:00PM, unless otherwise noted.

The nearest Metrorail stations are on the Red Line at Farragut North and Dupont Circle. Several Metrobus routes stop at Connecticut Avenue and M Street a short distance from the Cathedral. For further information or directions, please call the Rectory at 202-347-3215.

The Rectory has the same street address as the Cathedral. The Rectory entrance is located three doors to the right of the Cathedral main entrance, on Rhode Island Avenue.
