# WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

This process is only for adult Catholics who have been baptized and already celebrated their First Eucharist. Others should contact the Pastoral Associate for Faith Formation to discuss the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) process.

#### • <u>WEEKLY PREPARATION SESSIONS (*All four sessions are required.*)</u> 7 to 9pm on Thursday, May 2 in the North Conference Room 7 to 9pm on Thursday, May 9 in the North Conference Room 7 to 9pm on Thursday, May16 in the North Conference Room 7 to 9pm on Thursday, May 23 in the North Conference Room

These sessions explore the four pillars of the <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church</u> – Creed, Sacraments, Morality, and Prayer – to refresh your knowledge of the fundamentals of the Catholic faith. These sessions are structured around assigned readings, lecture, discussion, and prayer.

The North Conference Room is accessible through the glass-and-iron door at the base of the driveway leading into the public parking garage to the right of the front of the Cathedral. You can park in the garage for a flat fee of \$5.00 after 4pm and on weekends. There is limited street parking in front of the Cathedral (free after 6:30pm). Farragut North (L street exit) and Dupont Circle (South exit) on the Red Line are the closest Metro stations.

#### • <u>CONFIRMATION RETREAT (required)</u> 10 am to 3pm on Saturday, June 1 in the Great Hall

This retreat is a time of prayer and reflection in preparation for the celebration of Confirmation.

### **<u>CONFIRMATION CEREMONY (You must be able to attend this ceremony to be confirmed.)</u> 3pm Mass on Sunday, June 9 in the Cathedral [arrival time no later than 2pm]**

The Confirmation ceremony is for adults from parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Washington who are receiving the sacrament of Confirmation. Cardinal Donald Wuerl will preside at this Mass.

## • SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION/PENANCE (CONFESSION)

Before your Confirmation, be sure to receive the sacrament of Reconciliation/Penance (Confession).

## HOW DO I REGISTER?

#### **STEP 1: COMPLETE THE REGISTRATION FORM.**

Print and complete the two-page registration form. Do not leave any sections blank.

#### STEP 2: OBTAIN A COPY OF YOUR BAPTISM CERTIFICATE.

Contact the parish where you were baptized to request that copy of your baptism certificate (including any other sacramental notations) be mailed to you. **The original certificate issued to you at the time of your baptism is generally** <u>not</u> acceptable.

#### **STEP 3: IDENTIFY A SPONSOR AND OBTAIN A SPONSOR LETTER**

You must identify a fully initiated member of the Catholic Church (Latin or Eastern rite) to serve as your Confirmation sponsor. This person should be someone with whom you have an existing relationship, who takes her/his faith seriously, who will support you in your faith journey, and who can be present for the Confirmation ceremony. If you wish, you may ask one of your original godparents, reinforcing the connection between Baptism and Confirmation. Your sponsor is welcome, though not required, to attend the weekly preparation sessions and the retreat. S/he will attend the Confirmation ceremony.

The Church requires the following of a sponsor:

- ✓ Be an active, practicing Catholic who has been baptized and confirmed and has received the sacrament of the Eucharist
- Be at least sixteen years of age
- ✓ Lead a life of faith in harmony with the ministry s/he is undertaking and have the intention of undertaking this ministry. A married Catholic who has not been married in the Church may <u>not</u> serve as a sponsor. A sponsor also must be able and willing to receive the Eucharist (Communion) the day of the ceremony.
- ✓ Not be a parent of the individual to be confirmed

# Please ask the sponsor whom you have chosen to contact his or her pastor/parish where s/he is registered to obtain a sponsor letter/certificate. This letter will state a sponsor meets the above requirements. Be sure to include this letter in your registration packet.

#### **STEP 4: CHOOSE A CONFIRMATION SAINT.**

It is the custom of the Catholic Church for each person pursuing Confirmation to select a saint of the Church to serve as an intercessor and patron. It also is customary that each person be presented to the (arch)Bishop on the day of Confirmation with this name. So we ask you to select the name of a saint you admire, a saint who is a model for you of living the Christian life. Doing so connects us more deeply with the Communion of Saints.

#### STEP 5: SUBMIT COMPLETE REGISTRATION PACKET NO LATER THAN MONDAY APRIL 29, 2019

The program fee is \$50.00. Part of this fee covers the required text, *United States Catholic Catechism for Adults*, which you will receive at the first preparation session. Please contact Theresa Prymuszewski in case of financial need.

A complete registration packet consists of:

- ✓ Registration form (with all information requested provided)
- ✓ New copy of your baptism certificate
- ✓ Sponsor letter
- ✓ Program fee of \$50.00 (cash or check payable to St. Matthew's Cathedral)

The deadline to register is *Monday, April 29* You can bring your complete packet to St. Matthew's Rectory during office hours (9am to 8pm Monday through Thursday, 9am to 4pm Friday through Sunday), or mail them to:Ms. Theresa Prymuszewski
