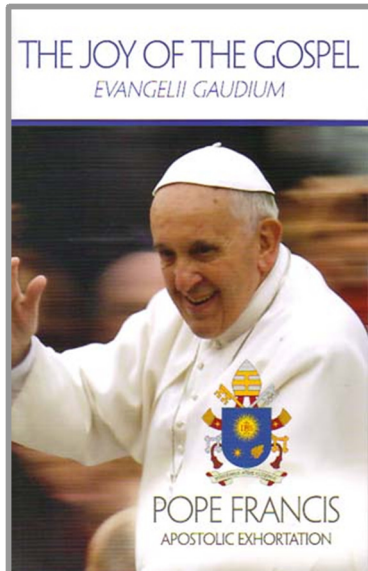
Fall Lecture Series *Evangelii Gaudium* *The Joy of the Gospel*
