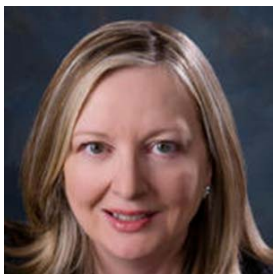

She joined the Hudson Institute as a Senior Fellow in November 2006, where she directs the Center for Religious Freedom. Ms. Shea works extensively for the advancement of individual religious freedom and other human rights in U.S. foreign policy as it confronts an ascendant form of Islamist extremism. In the summer of 2014 she met with Pope Francis to discuss the persecution of Christians in the Middle East.
