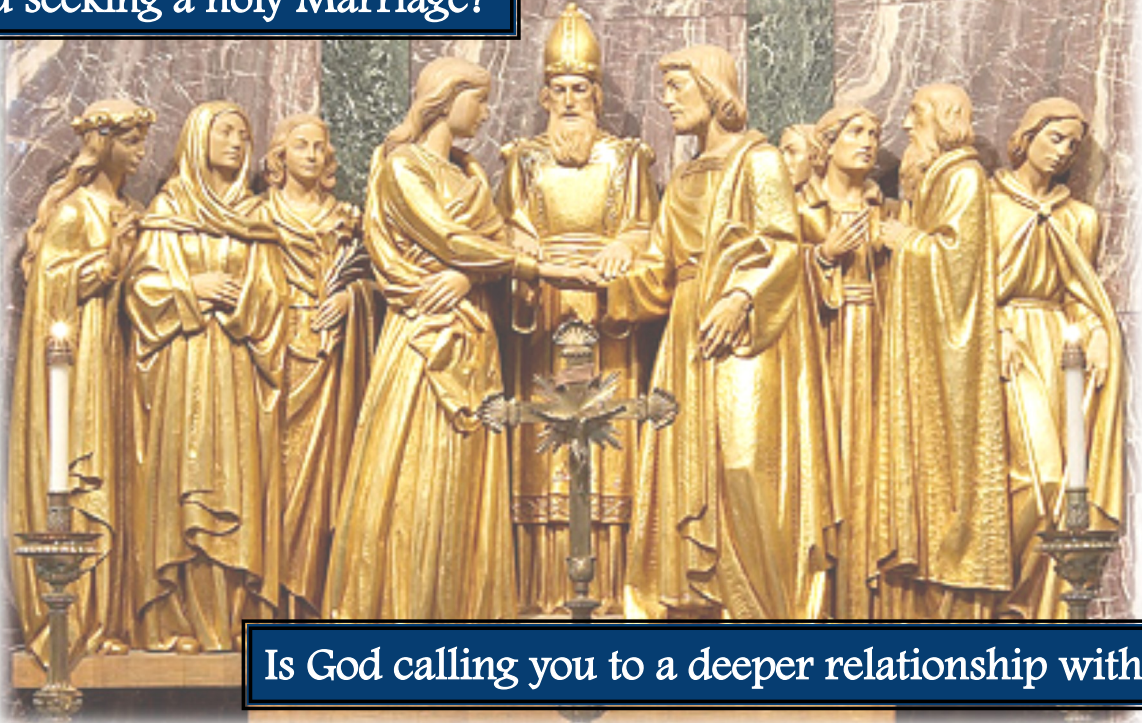


Seeking a Christ-centered Marriage?
