In the Gospel according to John, Jesus promises to give the Samaritan woman “living water” that will quench all her thirsts and will gush out from within her like a living spring giving her eternal life: “...those who drink of the water that I will give them will never be thirsty...” (Jn 4:14). This morning of recollection will provide the space and time for you to get in touch with your thirsts, your longings, your deepest desires that we Christians believe, in faith, can only be satisfied by Jesus, the One who gives us eternal life. The focus of the retreat will be the gospel passage of John 4:5-42, the Woman at the Well, which has a long tradition of being proclaimed in the Church during the season of Lent.

Sister Parachini, who currently teaches at Washington Theological Union, has more than forty years of experience as a pastoral theologian, educator, and spiritual director.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION FOR ADULTS AND CHILDREN

For adults interested in learning more about the Catholic faith and/or becoming Catholic, Inquiry meets on the second Wednesday of each month (September through May) from 6:30 to 7:30pm in the East Conference Room. A brief overview of the entire adult initiation process [Rite of the Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)] can be presented after Inquiry for those who are interested.

St. Matthew's offers adult Confirmation preparation for active, baptized Catholics in the weeks between Easter and Pentecost. The celebration of adult Confirmation in 2012 will occur at a special Mass on Pentecost Sunday, May 27 (Memorial Day weekend). The preparation includes five weekly sessions on consecutive Thursday evenings – April 19, 26 and May 3, 10, and 17 – and a Saturday retreat on May 19.

St. Matthew's offers sacramental preparation and ongoing religious education for school-age children.

ARCHDIOCESAN OPPORTUNITIES

Hearts Aflame is an adult faith and ministries formation program founded on Sacred Scripture and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The Hearts Aflame Program enables adults to deepen their knowledge of the faith and prepare to exercise a variety of ministries in the life of the Church. Hearts Aflame offers courses in both English and Spanish for all interested adults throughout the Archdiocese: Christian Prayer, Christian Morality, Sacraments, Creed, and Introduction to Sacred Scripture.
