The Cathedral of St. Matthew the Apostle is celebrating the Season of Creation for the third year. The **burning bush**, the Symbol for the Season of Creation 2022, reminds us that God's Creation cries out as forests crackle, animals flee, and people are forced to migrate due to the fires of injustice. Huge swaths of the planet are cooking in recordbreaking heatwaves. Raging wildfires, some visible from space, have ripped through the US and EU. Over 1,100 people have died in devastating floods brought on by record monsoon rains in Pakistan. And the worst drought in 40 years in Eastern Africa could push up to 20 <u>MILLION</u> people into severe hunger.

On the contrary, the fire that called to Moses as he tended the flock on Mt. Horeb did not consume or destroy the bush. This flame of the Spirit revealed God's presence. This holy fire affirmed that God heard the cries of all who suffered and promised to be with us as we followed in faith to our deliverance from injustice. In this <u>Season of Creation</u>, this symbol of God's Spirit calls us to listen to the voice of creation – and thereby we'll touch all <u>Seven Laudato Si' Goals</u> of the Vatican's and the ADW's Laudato Si' Action Plan.
