Advocacy & Education

St. Matthew's supports Catholic social justice teachings on, and participates in advocacy efforts related to, issues that include poverty, access to healthcare, and affordable housing, and environmental justice, among others.

Educates students in English as a second language to help advance their life's vocation. and so that they can better navigate the day-to-day challenges involved in employment, social life, family, and immigration. We teach Spanish to community members so that they can better communicate with their neighbors of different language backgrounds.

Care for Creation Green Team

Dedicated to developing a deeper awareness of our duties to God's creation and to acting at the individual, state, and national levels with a focus on prayer, energy efficiency, conservation, and advocacy efforts.

Every Monday we welcome guests from the Cathedral neighborhood who are homeless or otherwise in need. We serve breakfast and provide bagged lunches, toiletries, new underwear, and socks.
